

Coastline invites school students between the ages of 5 and 18 to submit a photograph for the Coastline Education Week 2023 photography competition.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. There are four age categories:

- 5-8 year old
- 9-12 year old
- 13-15 year old
- 16-18 year old

2. The Photograph

- One photo only per entrant.
- Photography must be printed on A4.
- Can be vertical or horizontal.

3. Preparing the photograph for entry

Fill in and submit the entry form online.

Clearly label the back of the photograph with which way it should be displayed, along with name, age, address, school, and contact details. Make sure this doesn't show through to the front.

Do NOT roll or fold the photograph. We suggest placing it between two pieces of cardboard to protect it and keep it flat.

4. Return of photograph

you must indicate on the entry form if you wish to have your photograph returned.

You must pick up the photograph in person or a representative from your school must collect the artworks by 15th September 2023 or the photographs will be disposed of.

5. Exhibition

The photograph will be displayed at our Coastline Photography Hub (Shop 3 – 4 Settlement City, Port Macquarie NSW 2444) for the month of August 2023.

6. Prizes

Coastline will be holding an in-branch competition.

In-Branch Competition:

To determine the winner for each category, the judging will be done by the public who come into the branch and vote for their favourite photograph! One photograph in each age category will receive the "People's Choice" award and win a \$100 gift card. Two photographs in each category will be highly commended and will receive a \$20 gift card, this will be judged by a local photographer!

7. Other terms and conditions

Entry is open to all kids aged 5-18 in the Mid North Coast.

The photograph submitted must be the original work of the entrant themselves and not infringe the copyright, moral rights, or other rights of any third party. Photographs that are deemed to not belong to or be created by the entrant will NOT be eligible.

Coastline can take no responsibility for any loss or damage to a photograph entry while in its possession.

8. Judging

The judges' decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.

9. Licensing the photograph

Entrants (including winners and highly commended) grant Coastline non-exclusive rights to reproduce their photograph in material form, to photograph, publish and/or communicate it to the public for the following competition-related purposes, and anything incidental to such purposes, by Coastline, competition partners and sponsors: marketing, publicity, educational and publication uses for Coastline, the competition and its exhibition in all media, including but not limited to electronic/digital, broadcasting and print media, in perpetuity. Permission to so reproduce the work must be conveyed by the entrant to any purchaser of the work. Where reasonable, Coastline will attribute the artists as the author of the work and reproduce the work in full. Details of the work may be used at Coastline's discretion. Entrants (including winners and highly commended) will not be entitled to any fee for such use.
